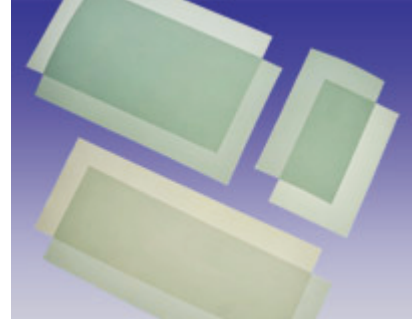


# Circular Polarizers

## Uses:

Circular polarizers are used to improve the viewability of emissive displays. In bright light environments, Electro Luminescent (EL), Field Emissive Displays (FED), Cathode Ray Tube (CRT), Light Emitting Diode (LED) and Organic Light Emitting Diode (OLED) benefit greatly from the use of a circular polarizer.

Circular polarizers are also used in camera, video and sensor applications where sensitivity to linearly polarized light is an issue, but glare reduction is required. Circular polarizers are also used in 3D applications as an alternative to linear polarizers.
